CNC milling & turning

Continued investment in the latest machinery along with an experienced workforce, gives ABG the platform to develop strong relationships with our customers. With the aid of CAD-CAM technology the machining of engineering plastics into precision components is our core business.

The large range of CNC mills and machining centres can handle a variety of work, from one-off complex prototyping through to high volume batch components. Two axis and driven tool three axis CNC controlled lathes also allow ABG to produce parts from thin walled bushes to large wheels with bar feeding up to 90mm diameter.






CNC routing

To complement the milled and turned component work we have our CNC routing section with off-line CAD-CAM programming, dealing with the larger plastic panel requirements. Vacuum bed sizes of up to 3m x 2m and a twin head option allows ABG to comprehensively respond to customer requirements.

With the processing of Acetal, Nylon, PETP, Polyethylene, Polypropylene, PTFE and PVC our experienced machinists ensure consistency of quality, whilst our unrivalled knowledge of the materials available enables us to advise customers on product suitability.





fabrication

ABG has an extensive in-house plastic fabrication section, offering welding, bonding, forming and polishing with hot line bending up to 3m long. The department has an oven facility to pre-dry, anneal and, when necessary, heat soften sheet prior to drape forming.

Skills within this department allow ABG to offer customers the benefit of our expertise to assist in the development of their products.

Supplying fabricated products for industrial and commercial applications, ensures we are able to handle a wide range of materials. The preferred materials are Polycarbonate, PETG, Acrylic, Polypropylene, Polyethylene and PVC.





pressed parts

The use of steel cutting forms in our press section enables the production of gaskets and seals from our stock range of Natural, Insertion, Neoprene, Nitrile, Shot-blast, EPDM, Silicone, Viton and Food Quality rubber sheet along with Matting, Polyurethane, CNAF, Sponge, Bonded Cork and PVC Coated Fabric.

In many applications thin plastic sheet can also be pressed as a cost effective alternative to machining. The 'Travelling Head', 'Beam' and 'Swing Arm' presses are supported with slitting, drilling and hand-cut work, giving ABG a full complement of options to meet our customers needs.
